

Worship at Radiant Church during the Covid-19 Pandemic

1. Attend an in-person Sunday worship service at either 9 or 10:45am.
2. Stay home and worship online at our You tube station Radiant Winona.

Services will be posted the next day by 3pm.

If you choose to attend an in-person worship service, we are committed to complying with health and safety guidelines to make every effort to protect our communities.

During worship gatherings, our buildings will be limited to 50% occupancy with a maximum of 200 people in the building. We will have ongoing sanitization in all areas, and an adjusted seating plan to accommodate additional spacing.

With the recent proclamation from our Mayor in response to a spike in cases we are asking that face coverings be worn while in the building during public gatherings until further notice.

Radiant Church is committed to the health of our community and will scale our gatherings in compliance with the Minnesota Department of Health and CDC guidance to support efforts in bringing this pandemic to an end in a holistically healthy way.

REOPENING FAQs

WILL RADIANT CHURCH BE AVAILABLE ONLINE?

We are currently updating our technology to be able to provide a high quality livestream. Until that is ready to go live we are posting Sunday services the following Monday afternoon by 3pm on our you tube station – Radiant Winona.

WHAT ABOUT KIDS AND YOUTH PROGRAMS?

These are the guidelines we will follow:

Volunteers and children over the age three and up are asked to wear face masks.

We ask that each child (and volunteer) get their temperature taken before entering the classroom.

All persons entering classrooms will be asked to wash their hands or use sanitizer before entering.

Rooms will be sanitized and disinfected on a weekly basis.

Radiant Youth is meeting on Wednesday nights from 7 to 8:30 pm

The same safety and health protocols that are in place for our weekend services will apply to YTH services – appropriate personal distancing, wearing face coverings, etc.

WILL TEMPERATURE CHECKS BE REQUIRED?

At this time, we are not requiring temperature checks for adult services, but are requiring temperature checks for children before entering their classroom.

WHAT ABOUT THOSE WHO ARE CONSIDERED MORE VULNERABLE OR CARING FOR THOSE WHO ARE?

If you're vulnerable for any reason we are encouraging you to remain home. If you have any symptoms of sickness or have been around anyone who has shown symptoms, we ask you to remain home from Radiant Church buildings for at least 14 days.

LET'S WORK TOGETHER TO STAY HEALTHY

What We're Doing:

- Additional hand-sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the building.
- All Radiant services will be as touchless as possible and all high-volume areas will be thoroughly sanitized between services.
- Only the baby and toddler room will be open during the second service.
- No cafe food (donuts) will be offered.
- No offering buckets will be passed. Instead, there will be an area in the back of the auditorium for guests who want to give in person. We recommend you give online (radiantwinona.churchcenter.com) at this time.
- To reduce touchpoints, connect cards, pens and offering envelopes will not be available in seating areas.

How You Can Help:

- If you don't feel well or have health concerns, please stay home and join us online at our You Tube channel at Radiant Winona. Services will be posted by 3pm on the Monday following the service.
- Please wash your hands, use hand sanitizer often and mitigate a sneeze or cough.
- Maintain a distance of six or more feet between yourself and other guests.
- Please respect the personal health decisions of others.
